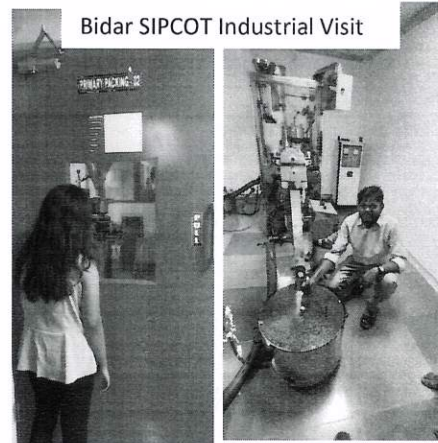



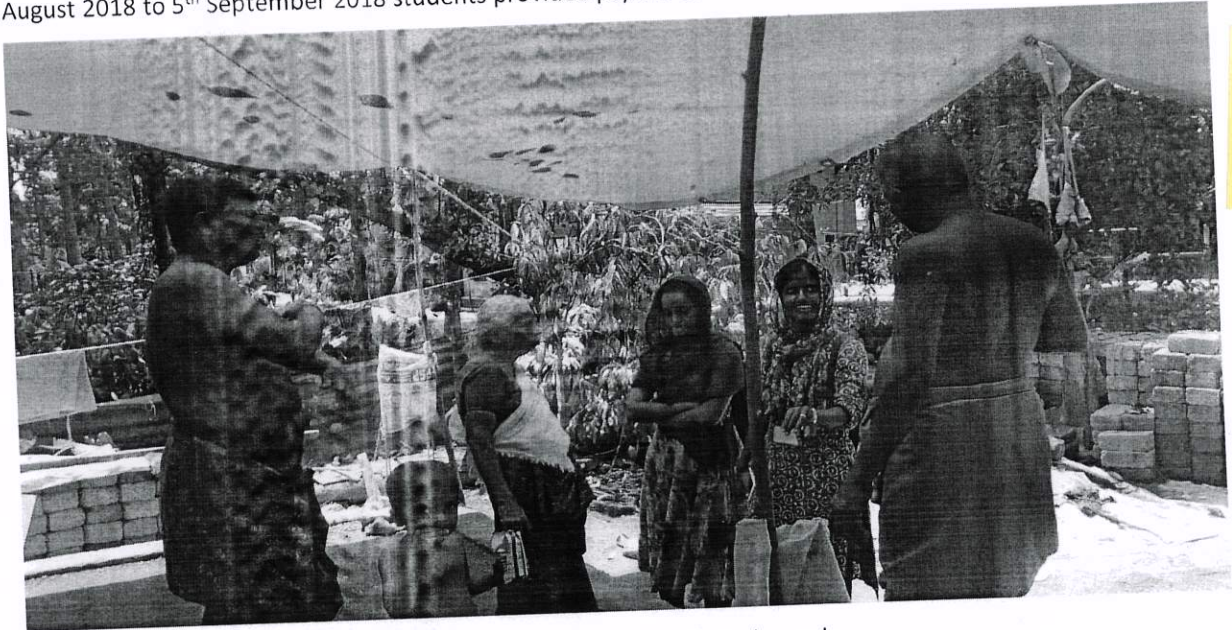

On 26th August 2018 students visited Karadiyod village, where massive land slide happened.



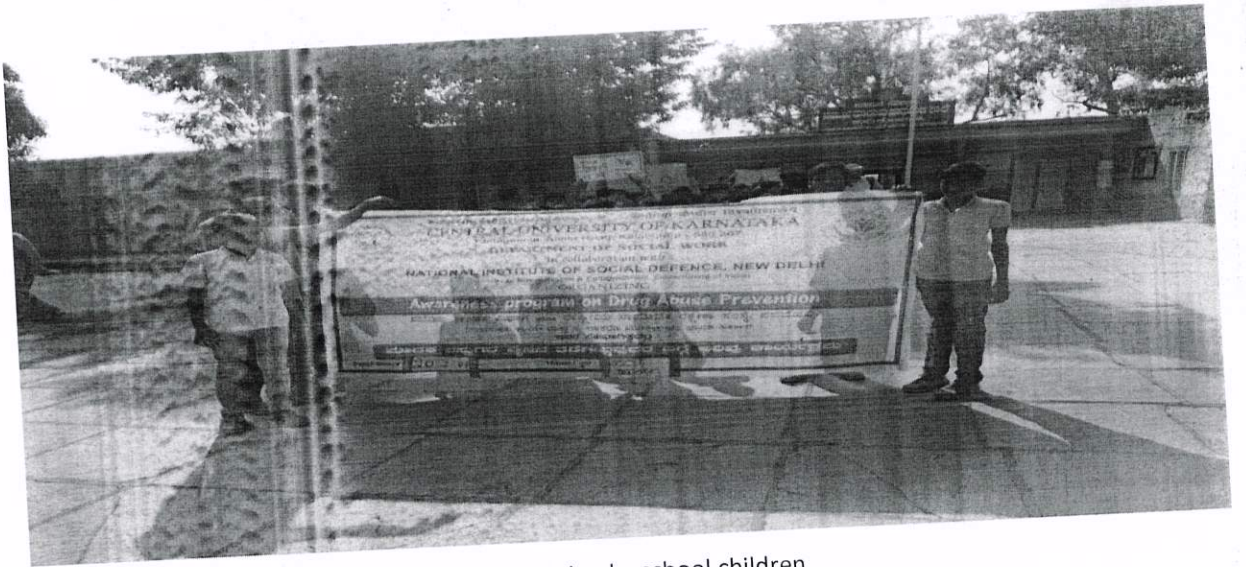


Students interacting with flood affected people

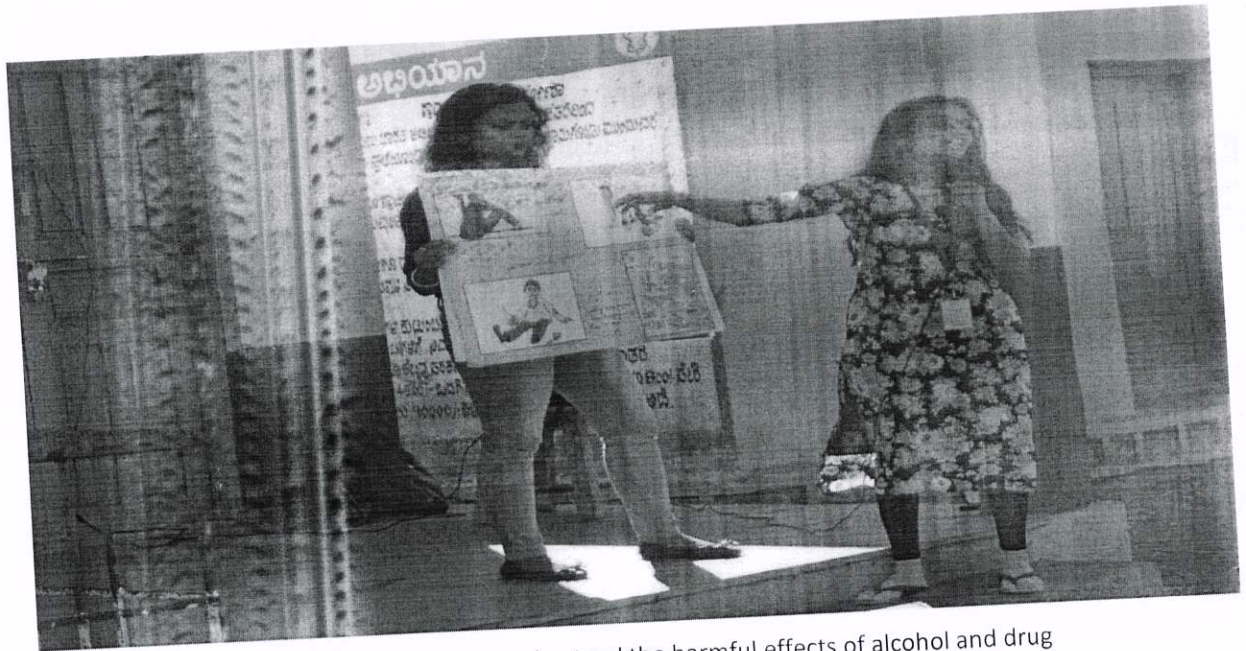
b) Awareness Program on Drug Abuse Prevention

As a part of elective paper i.e. Rural Communication students are expected to complete 30 hours field work. Total 57 semester I students participated in the field work. Ten villages were selected and students were divided into ten groups. During field work, students conducted various field work activities such as rallies, street plays, poster exhibition, guest lectures for the villagers and cultural programs. In these ten villages students also conducted a survey of addicted people to understand the prevalence, aetiology, their readiness to change/quit alcohol and their mental health. Around 1,500 addicted people were surveyed.

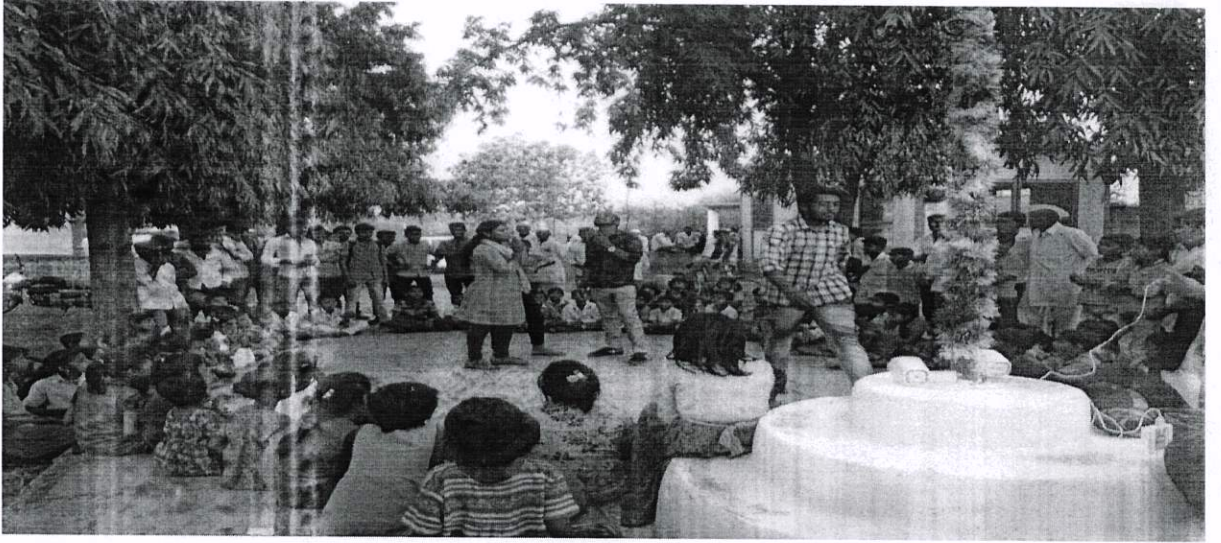

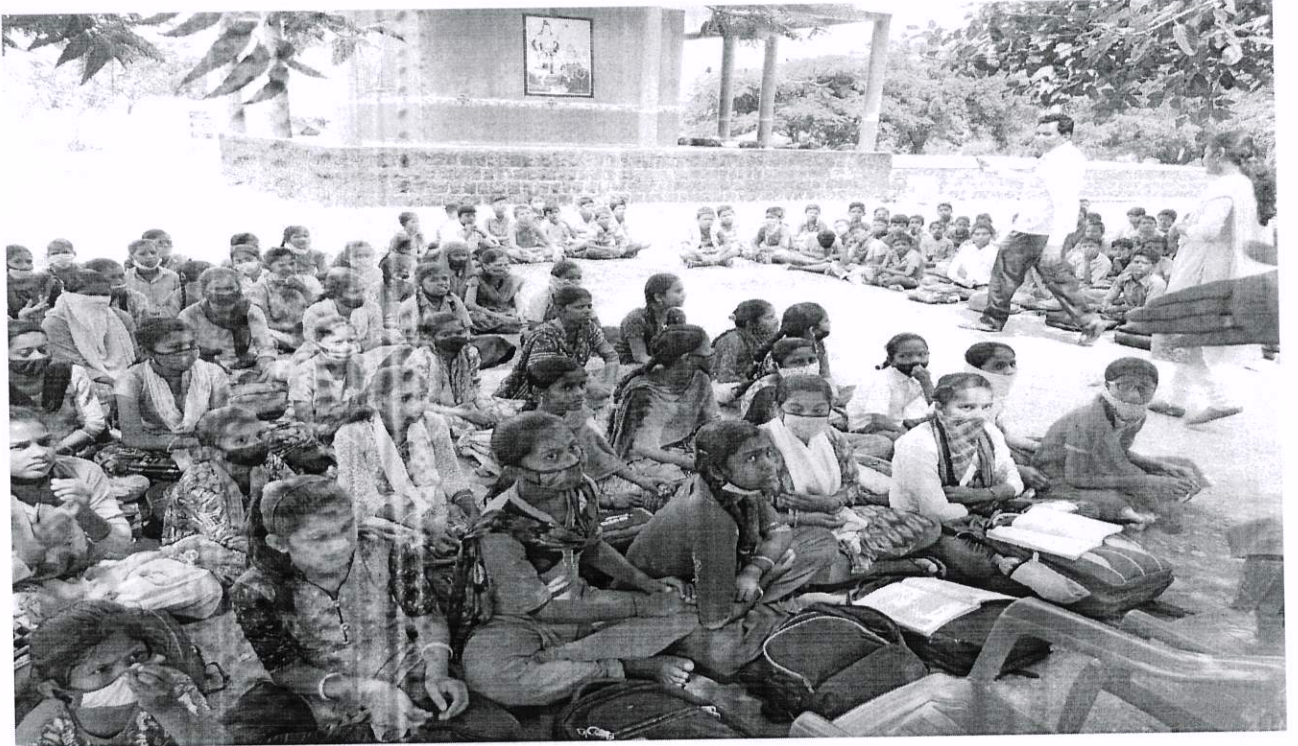

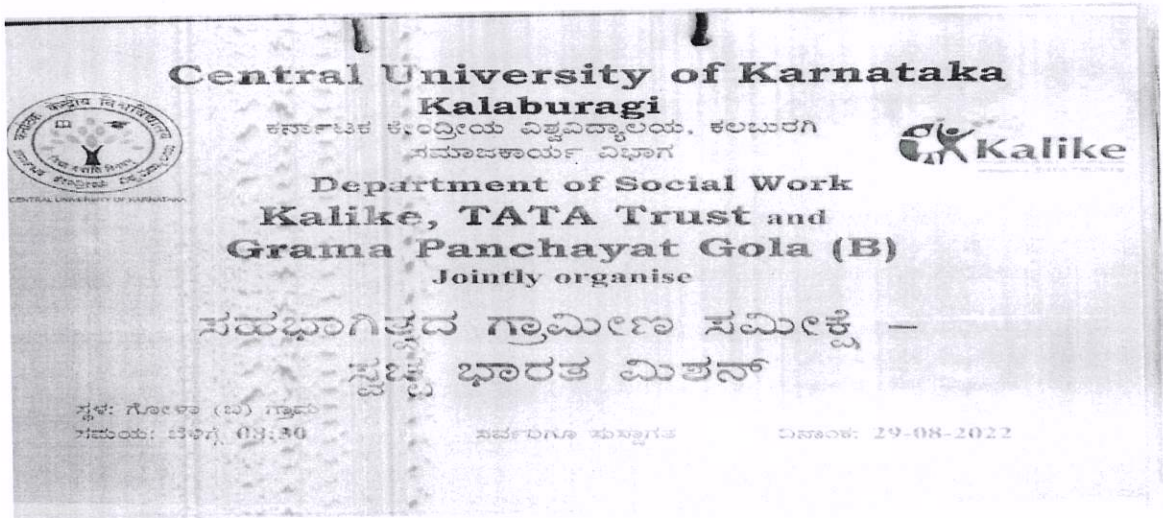

COMMUNITY EXTENSION PROGRAMMES DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WORK

The Department of Social Work has undertaken extension programmes in the neighbouring villages of Central University of Karnataka. Kalika Kendras have started as collaborative extension programmes from 2022 onwards.

Kalika Kendras (Remedial Coaching Centres)

Department of Social Work in collaboration with the Gram Vikas, Kalaburagi has started a collaborative social venture of the Kalika Kendras in the neighbouring villages of the Central University of Karnataka. Around 150 children are getting benefit of the remedial coaching in the following villages -

1. Kadaganchi
2. Tellur
3. Gola (B)
4. Savalgi (B), and
5. Gunj Bablad


In the villages, many children have problem of educational backwardness and the learning related problems. In order to improve the academic level of the rural children, education support in the form of remedial coaching to the children was started in different villages. A teacher is appointed on an honorarium to teach the children. The teacher attends routinely the following duties -

1. Update the school assignments and home work of the children.
2. Teach the children to improve their language aptitude
3. Teach the children to improve their science aptitude.
4. Teach the children to improve their mathematical aptitude.

In every Kalika Kendra, the children are motivated to improve their knowledge through extra coaching.

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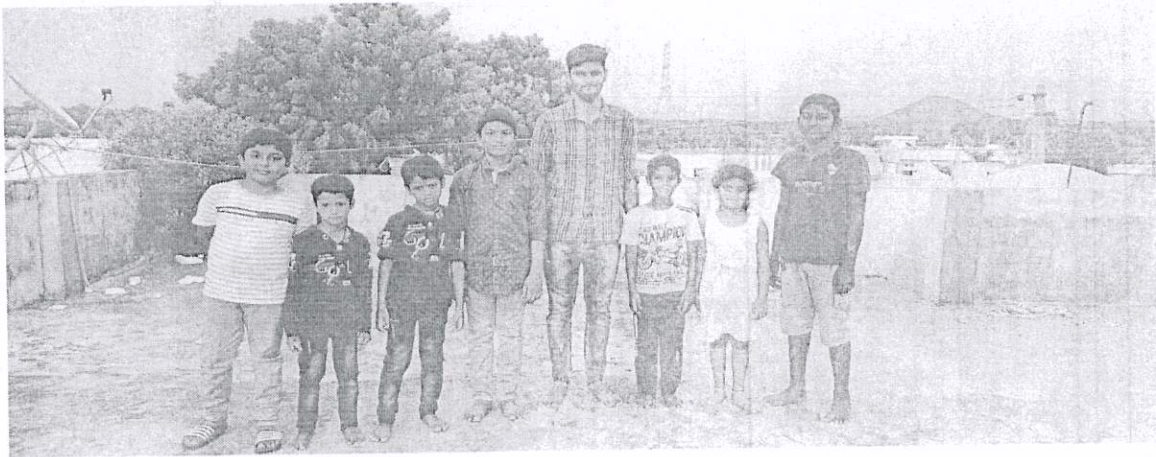
LIFE SKILLS PROGRAMMES IN THE COMMUNITIES

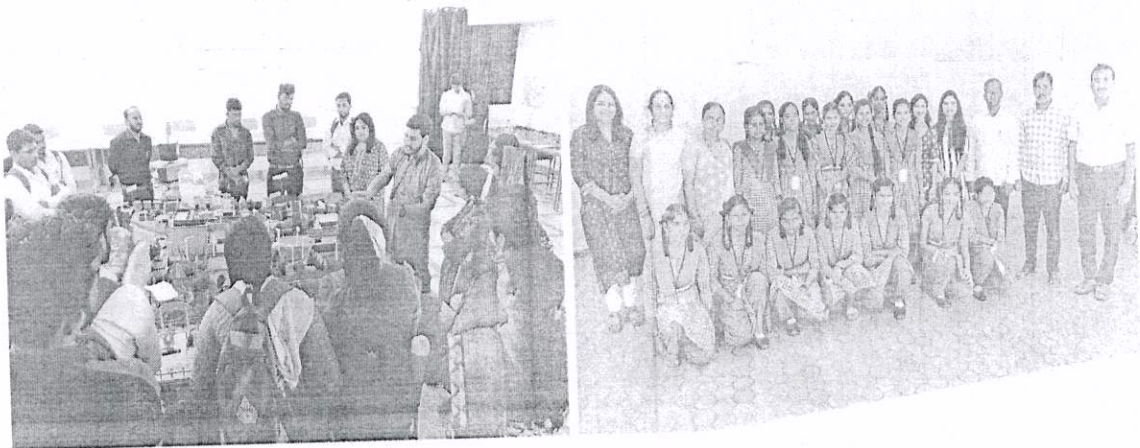

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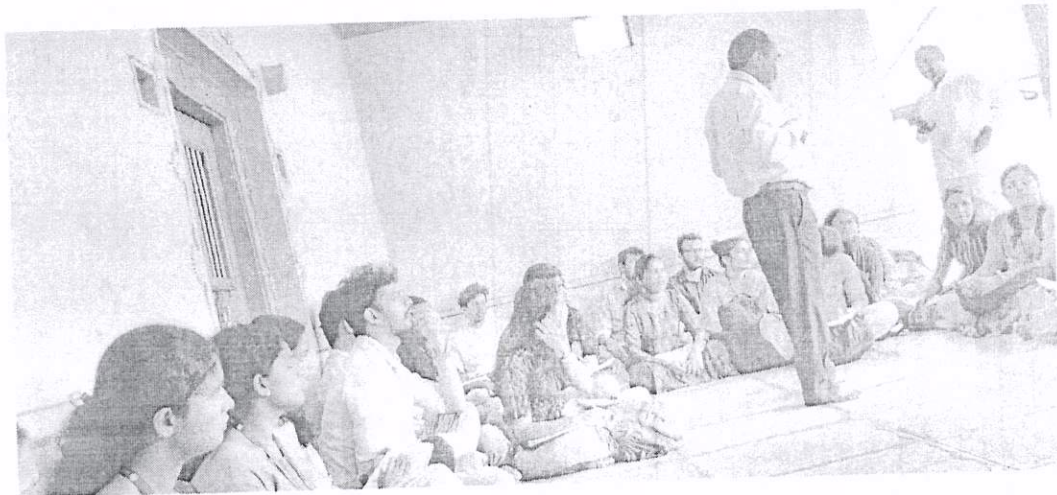
UNIVERSITY – COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT




It was a rare opportunity to forge the university-community engagement through the rural school children visiting the university to gain orientation to the development models.

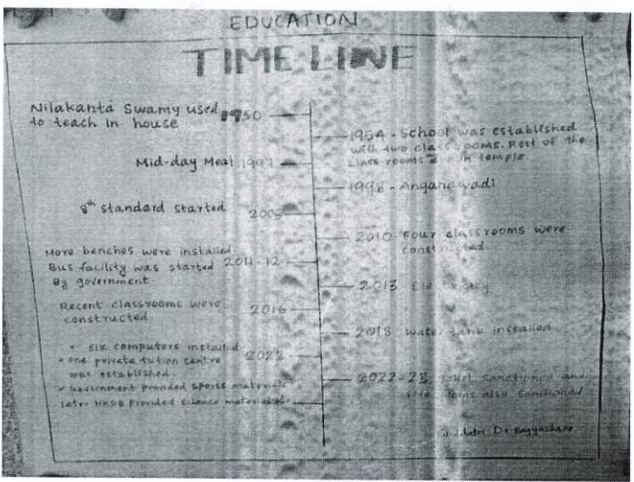

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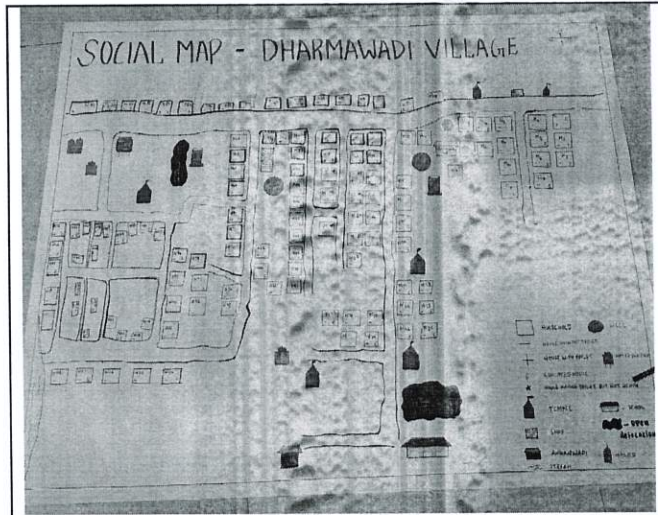
Fig.3) Time line and Trend analysis

SOCIAL DEVELOPMENT REPORT ON MENTORING AND HAND-HOLDING SUPPORT FOR EMPOWERING THE WOMEN NRLM GROUPS IN GUNJBABALAD VILLAGE, KALABURAGI – 2023

Background:


Gunjbabalad is a village situated at 18 km distance from the Central University of Karnataka, Kalaburagi. The village is quite interior from the main road. The total geographical area of village is 830.66 hectares. Gunjbablalad has a total population of 1,605 peoples, out of which male population is 813 while female population is 792. Literacy rate of Gunjbablalad village is 57.20% out of which 64.21% males and 50.00% females are literate. There are about 310 houses in Gunjbablalad village. The demographic statistics of the village indicates low literacy rate. The households of the village primarily rely on the agriculture as main occupation for their livelihood. However, dairy activity is quite active in the village; which generates daily income to supports their day-to-day expenditure.

Poverty and unemployment:

The village is having less options for sustainable livelihood. Many youths migrate to cities in search of jobs. Early marriages also take place, which is a prominent problem for the girl children. Poverty and unemployment are the serious problems the village has been confronted with for decades. The Self-help groups were not active in raising their social and economic capital.

NRLM Groups and Social Development :

There are 22 SHG NRLM Groups consist of around 350 women members. Three of the SHGs belong to social disadvantaged section. Most of the SHGs were taking revolving fund to meet their expenses. No SHG had any livelihood plan. The members of the NRLM groups lacked business skills, marketing skills and networking skills. Subsequently, poverty and unemployment problems of the village could not be tackled despite the NRLM support.


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CUK and NRLM Groups:

Department of Social Work, Central University of Karnataka identified the Gunjablad village to take up Social Development programmes to support the NRLM groups to ensure their sustainable livelihoods.

Following Social Development programmes were implemented –

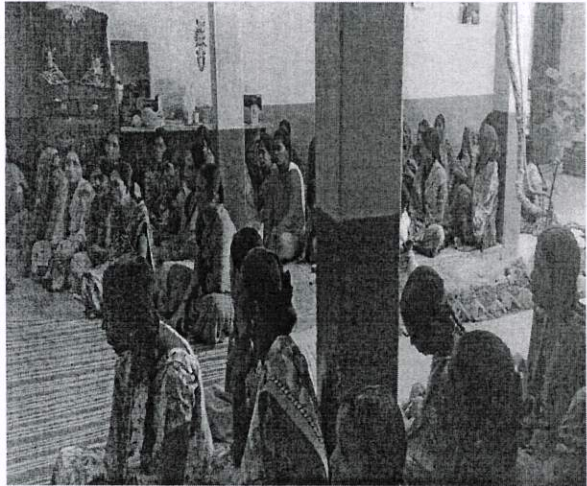
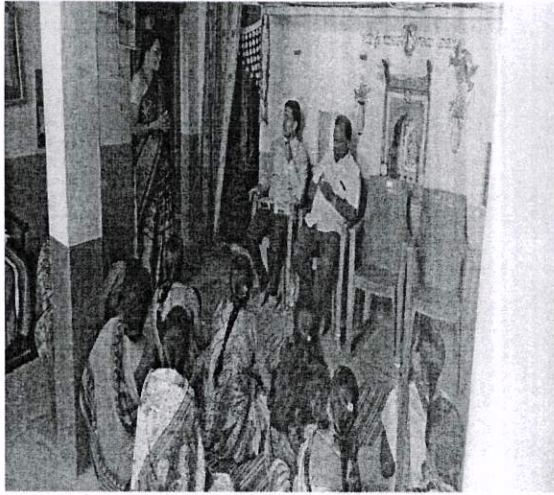
1. Social mobilization of the NRLM Groups
2. Discussion and perspective building on Village Poverty Reduction Plan
3. Introduce Skill development programmes
4. Promote business activities
5. Provide market linkages to the NRLM group produces
6. Improve income and contribute to poverty reduction.

A series of village development activities were promoted engaging the NRLM groups, youth groups and other stakeholders of the village and NRLM program i.e. Zilla panchayat nodal officers.

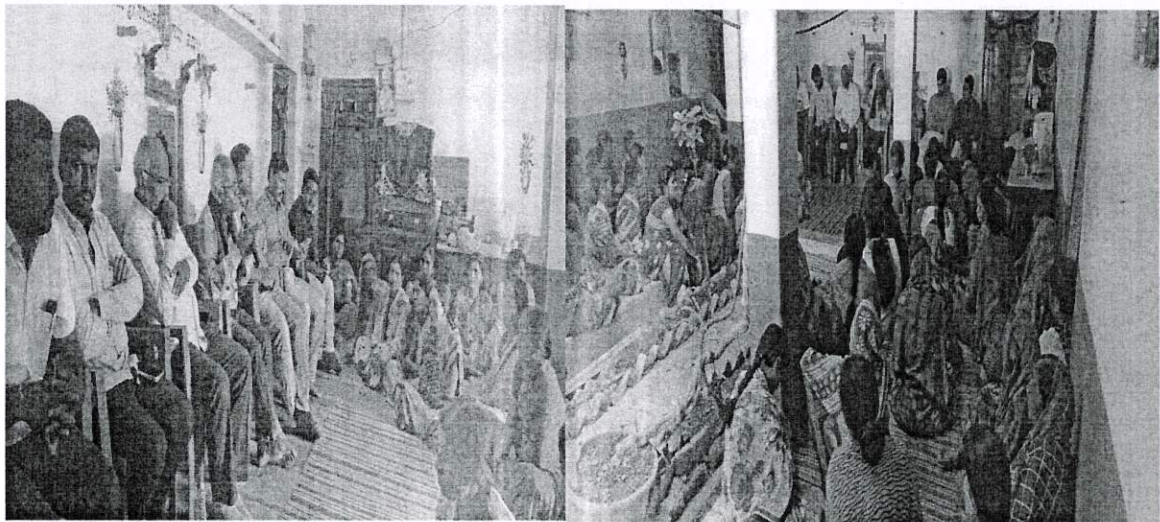
