Best Practice: 1

Title of the Practice: Enhancing bio-diversity and establishing fully Eco-friendly campus

1. Objectives of the Practice:

 To create eco-friendly academic campus to host good through plantation drive and waste management system and to reduce the carbon footprint.

a. The Context

The university is located in the tropical and drought prone zone of the north Karnataka region. The university initiated to create eco-friendly campus through plantation of diverse trees and implementing a systematic waste management system, transforming the campus into lash green, and clean environment. These initiatives lead to growth of fauna and flora in the campus making it ecofriendly. Furthermore, a diverse range of fauna species now thrives within the campus environment. The harmonious coexistence of fauna and flora has fostered a clean and eco-friendly atmosphere, conducive to the well-being of all inhabitants within the campus and its vicinity.

b. The Practice

The university made the annual drives for plantation trees during the start of monsoon season every year. Apart from that many departments also planted numerous trees around their departments wherever they organized the events and activities. Some special plantation drives were also organized in collaboration with the Karnataka forest department and other NGOs. This lead to conversion of dry land into a lush green campus within short period. The shortage of water for plants and trees was managed by reutilizing the waste water after treatment.

c. Evidence of Success

The initiative lead to creation of a large scale Eco-Zone on the CUK Campus, with the plantation of plenty of trees including **1800 fruit trees of 9 varieties** under the able guidance of Prof. Battu Satyanarayana, Hon. Vice Chancellor. There are 16 fauna and 161 flora are identified in the campus. The plantation area of around 50 acres is completely dedicated for the fruit trees to attract different species of birds to the campus. Apart the above drive, the following activities, which promote the concept of green campus has been undertaken by our staffs. Landscape drive was done by the entire university to maintain greenery throughout the university. To reduce the corban emission restrictions were introduced on the movement of fossil fuel vehicles.

Problems Encountered and Resources Required

University encountered problem of water shortage during the summer days. To overcome this problem, university initiated many solutions such as reuse of treated waste water, scheduling vacation during mid of the summer season, etc.



Title of the Practice: COVID-19 Testing laboratory CUK

 To help the government and people of the Kalaburagi in Covid-19 testing during the pandemic

a. The Context

The population of Kalaburagi is over 5 lakhs. Majority of these are rural region where facility for COVID-19 testing was scarce. The Central University of Karnataka helped government by setting up COVID 19 testing lab as per ICMR guidelines with the help of its faculty members form the Dept. of Life Science with the financial assistance from the GoK. The laboratory was inaugurated on 5th Nov 2020 by Dr. Rajshekhar Malli (DHO, Kalaburagi), Prof. H M Maheshwaraiah (Vice Chancellor, CUK) and Prof. G R Naik (Former Pro Vice Chancellor, CUK).

a. The Context

Central university of Karnataka is aspiring to become research centric university, thus research and innovation have remained our central focus. Also, research training in cutting edge areas to the faculty members is integral to imparting quality training to the students. Thus, to incentivize the faculty members making impact in quality research, innovation and IP generation, CUK has introduced best research award since 2021.

b. The Practice:

Every year CUK invites school-wise nominations for this award from the eligible faculty members. The expert committee scrutinizes the application and finalize the paper/researcher awardees based on the published guidelines. Awardees are presented with a certificate and a memento.

c. Evidence of Success

After introducing the Best Researcher Award, the CUK secured a place in 151-200 band in National Institute Ranking Framework (NIRF) for the first time in 2022 ranking. One of our faculty member in mathematics also got a place in top 2% scientists published by Stanford University. University ensured that faculties should publish their publication only in UGC care list, Scopus and Web of Science.

More financial support is needed to extend this award to large number of deserving faculty members.





I. About lab:

The population of Kalaburagi is more than 5 lakhs which includes most of the areas under rural region, which are deficit of availability of proper medical facility to combat COVID-19 due to very fast spread of this disease. As per the present rate it is expected COVID-19 cases can further increase due to several factors. To ensure adequate screening, establishment of additional COVID-19 testing center is crucial, especially in the area encompassing in the rural areas. The Central University of Karnataka can play a pivotal role in screening of COVID-19 cases, as the University is located near rural area Kadaganchi village, in Aland taluka; however well connected to the main city. In view of the above, Central University of Karnataka has established molecular diagnosis and research laboratory to test COVID-19 samples, approved by NIMHANS, ICMR and Govt. of India that is supported by MHRD and State Govt. of Karnataka to strengthen the testing efficiency for Kalaburagi region. This laboratory was inaugurated on 5th Nov 2020 by Dr. Rajshekhar Malli (DHO, Kalaburagi), Prof. H M Maheshwaraiah (Former Vice Chancellor, CUK) and Prof. G R Naik (Former Pro Vice Chancellor, CUK).

The COVID-19 Testing laboratory CUK has been recognized as reallocation center by State Surveillance Unit (SSU) and mapped to multiple state medical hospitals and COVID 19 testing centers as following
